SENTRAL

Our school has moved to a new platform for absences, late arrivals and early departures. We are now using Sentral.

Sentral will automatically let parents know when their child is marked absent. There have been a couple of teething problems, and we apologise if you received a message about your child being absent when they were late to class. Please make sure your child is brought to the office to sign in if they are late to school, this will ensure an automatic notification is not received by you. NEW COMMUNICATION

Communication with families is very important to us, and finding the best way to communicate has been an area we have worked on over the past few years. At the end of 2019 our school made the decision to cease working with Xuno as we felt their software did not meet our school

communities' needs. From the beginning of this year the school has been working with Sentral Education software to enhance our everyday operations.

We are now very excited to invite all our parents to access Sentral Education's Parent Portal for our school. Initially, we will be using the Sentral Parent Portal or App for parents to communicate student absences, book parent teacher interviews, access student reports and very shortly provide consent for excursions and incursions.

Eventually parents will also be able to see Newsletters, upcoming events, make payments, communicate with staff and potentially access progress reports. Sentral will be a one stop shop for all your communication needs.

Yesterday the school will emailed families their specific details for accessing their student/s information.

KITCHEN PROGRAM RECIPE

Mini Cheesecakes

Ingredients

100g plain biscuits, crushed
50g butter, melted
200g cream cheese
2 tbsp. sour cream
2 eggs
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 tsp vanilla essence



Method

1. Crush biscuits until they become fine crumbs. Pour in melted butter and mix to combine.

2. Distribute mixture evenly between 12 cupcake cases and put in fridge to set until the filling is ready.

3. Prepare the filling by beating the cream cheese and sour cream with an electric beater. Whisk in the sugar, eggs, and vanilla until smooth.

4. Remove the cupcake tray from the fridge and top each biscuit base with the filling. Bake in a moderate oven for 20-30 minutes until the filling is set. Cool on a rack and then serve.
